REFLECTION:

Wouldn't we all want all like to be wise.? Wisdom is a gift of the Holy Spirit received in Baptism and Confirmation. Wisdom is knowledge so pure that it directs the human will to obey the commands of God.

How can we grow in wisdom? God gave us the ten commandments and the five precepts of the Church.

- Attend Mass on Sundays and days of obligation (Christmas Day and the Feast of Mary, Mother of God.)
- Confess your sins at least once a year.
- Receive the Eucharist at least once a year.
- Observe days of fasting and abstinence.
- Provide for the needs of the Church.

Following these is the bare minimum to gaining wisdom. In fact, to not follow the commandments and precepts is considered sinful.

What else can we do to gain spiritual wisdom? We can attend daily Mass, be persistent, preserving and patient in daily prayer, pray Holy Scripture using Lectio Divina, pray the Liturgy of the Hours, seek out frequent spiritual direction and the sacrament of confession, read spiritual literature, such as classic and contemporary Catholic works, documents of the magisterium, words of the Holy Father and letters from the bishops, and practice devotions that we feel called to.

There is no middle ground. We are either striving to grow spiritually or our spiritual life is stagnating. Thankfully, God is patient and does not expect us to be wise saints overnight. Let us each, right now, choose one small way to grow in wisdom.
